

Constitution

Mountain View Chorus Boosters

Article I – Name

Section 1. The name of this organization shall be as set forth in the title of this Constitution.

Article II – Purpose

Section I. The purpose of this organization shall be to encourage and enlist cooperation and participation of the educational staffs/students and citizens with the objective of promoting the musical education of the student by:

- a. Encouraging the musical training of the students in all ways.
- b. Making known to the public the needs of the students in music programs.
- c. Adequately promoting and publicizing the importance of the band, chorus, and orchestra programs in the school community.
- d. Assisting the schools administrators and music staff in music education to the students and to the community.

Article III – Membership

Section 1. All parent or legal guardians of the students enrolled in the choral programs in the school systems, and any other persons interested in the organization are eligible for membership.

Section 2. Those eligible for membership shall become members upon payment of the membership fee set forth in the by-laws and enrollment upon the membership roll of the organization.

Article IV – Meetings

Section 1. Meeting shall be held as provided by the by-laws.

Article V – Officers

Section 1. The officers of this organization shall consist of a Liaison, Secretary, Treasurer, Fund Raising Chair and Uniform Coordinator. All officers, together with the chorus director and an elected representative of the music students shall constitute the Executive Committee, which shall have general administrative powers. The officers shall be selected as provided by the by-laws of this organization.

Article VI – Quorum

Section 1. A quorum shall be constituted by at least 10 members including at least three members of the Executive Committee.

Article VII – Amendments

Section 1. This constitution may be amended by a resolution adopted at any meeting at which a quorum of members is present and two thirds of those present vote for such an amendment; but, such amendment must be presented in writing by an active member at the meeting immediately preceding that at which the amendment is to be voted on.
