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A Chorus Letter at MVHS is an award of distinction. It signifies that the recipient has worked above and beyond the effort given by average choral students in all aspects of the choral program. In order to receive a letter (bar for students who have already received a letter) students must complete the following certification form. A **minimum of 50 points** are required for eligibility for a letter award. All points will be reviewed by the Chorus Director. Students must participate and receive **at least 2 points in fund-raising** activities for the chorus and they must complete **at least five service hours within the chorus program** to be eligible to receive an Honor Medal. These five service hours may be in a service project, music library, piano maintenance, student mentoring program for peers or middle school students, or any other chorus service activity approved by the director. It is the responsibility of the student to maintain documentation of points until such time as they are due. **Any student with** <u>any unexcused absence from rehearsal or performance will be disqualified from consideration for a letter or bar.</u>
